The wineries that will be providing tastes this year are: Alluvium Cellars, Coyote Canyon Winery, Dusty Cellars Winery, Edward Lynne Cellars, Ellensburg Canyon, Furion Cellars, Market Vineyards, Treveri Cellars, and Tricycle Winery. There will be an opportunity to order the wines by the bottle or case and proceeds will benefit the Arlington Education Foundation.
